

# Team Manager Development Programme

## Improving quality of practice in social care

Improvement in the quality of services is at the heart of social care reform, and it is front-line managers and senior practitioners who are responsible for delivering this improvement to citizens. The Team Manager Development Programme (TMDP) is designed specifically to help front-line managers and senior practitioners in Wales to improve the management of practice quality in their teams.

## Programme dates 2018-19

The programme has three compulsory modules and is studied over a twelve month period. Each module includes a two-day taught session and group support sessions combining facilitated action learning sets and individual support. The programme starts with detailed set-up and engagement activities, including a pre-programme seminar.
